Potted Trees	
Apple 'Anna'	Bred in Israel. Popular variety for warm climates. Sweet, crisp and flavorful.
Apple 'Dorsett Golden'	One of few apple varieties suitable for hot climates. Early variety with medium sized fruit and sweet flavor.
Asian Pear 'Tenosui'	Cross between Hosui Asian Pear and Tennessee European Pear. Yellow fruit with slight red blush
Peach 'Mid-Pride'	Good tree vigor with good quality fruit. Yellow-orange fruit with distinctive red striping. Freestone.
Peach 'Red Baron'	Beautiful pinkish-red, semidouble flowers, and high quality fruit. Self-fruitful. Semi-freestone.
Pear 'Biscamp'	Sweet, crisp apple-like texture. When ripened the fruit is soft and buttery. Developed by Dr. O'Rourke from LSU for insect and disease resistance.
Pear 'Kieffer'	Self fruitful. Large yellow fruit good for canning. Stores well.
Plum 'Burgundy'	Black plum that stays firm when fully ripe. Better fruit set when planted with a pollenizer like Santa Rosa.
Potted Blackberries	
Blackberry 'Big Daddy'	Thornless variety. Vigorous grower, fruits on 2nd year canes. Huge berries. Good for eating and jams.
Blackberry 'Prime-Ark® Freedom'	Thornless variety. Fruits in the first year. Early, at least 10 days before Natchez. Developed at the University of Arkansas.
Blackberry 'Kiowa'	Large fruited, thorny cultivar from The University of Arkansas. Top performer for Texas conditions
Blackberry 'Natchez'	Thornless. Large great tasting berries. Good production and growth with low chilling requirements
Blackberry 'Triple Crown'	Thornless. Fruits on second year canes. Berries ripen July-August. Plant is semi-erect and can be trellised.
Potted Fruit Trees and Shrubs	
Avocados:	
Avocado 'Joey'	Cold hardy Mexican variety. Skin is purple-black and egg-shaped fruit has excellent flavor. Heavy producer.
Avocado 'Lila'	Originated in Uvalde Texas. Vigorous tree. Hardy to mid teens. Green skinned avocado. Ripens August to September.
Avocado 'Mexicola Grande'	Has glossy, near black, thin, easy to peel skin. Tree is fast growing and very cold tolerant.
Blueberries:	
Blueberry 'Emerald'	Southern Highbush. Mild sweet flavor, abundant crop. Low chill hours.

Blueberry 'Gulf Coast'	Southern Highbush. Ripens early, producing medium-sized berries. Great quality.
Blueberry 'Powder Blue'	Rabbiteye. Excellent for hot humid climates. Large berries are light blue with a soft dusting
Blueberry 'Premier'	Rabbiteye. A superb tasting fruit with a little less production. Ripens early to mid season.
Blueberry 'Southern Belle'	Southern Highbush. High quality berries early in the season. Low chill hours.
Blueberry 'Windsor'	Southern Highbush. Produces a large crop and semi spreading growth habit.
Citrus:	
Grapefruit 'Rio Red'	Introduced in Texas. Fruit has excellent red color, with few or no seeds. Loves long hot summers.
Lemon 'Meyer Improved'	Small tree with continuous crops from August - January. Grows to about 10ft tall.
Lime - 'Mexican Thornless'	Also known as the bartender's lime. Mature fruit is small green, to yellow green, ripening July-December. Great in containers.
Mandarin 'Kishu'	Good for container growing. Fruit is small but very sweet, juicy and seedless. Matures early.
Orange 'Moro Blood'	Very colorful and delicious orange. Fruits are medium sized and seedless or with very few seeds. Ripens in December. Bears in alternate years.
Orange 'Republic of Texas'	Very cold tolerant. A sweet flavorful orange. Documented back to 1847 near Angleton, TX.
Satsuma 'Owari'	Very good flavor. Great production. Hardly any seeds. Slow growing but very productive.
Figs:	
Fig 'Celeste'	Great fruit tree for our area. Pest and disease resistant. Vigorous tree. Closed Eye. Produces on last year's wood.
Olive:	
Olive 'Arbequina'	Fast growing olive tree produces delicious fruit and oil. Will grow 15-20 ft tall. Self fertile and a good pollinator.
Pecans:	
Pecan 'Desirable'	Type I. Heavy pecan producer of round, well shaped fruit. Harvest date mid October.
Pecan 'Elliott'	Type II. Considered one of the most disease-resistant varieties. Small, prolific nut of excellent quality. Scab resistant.
Pecan 'Oconee'	Type I. Produces large nuts of outstanding quality and flavor. Adequate disease resistant. Early pollen release.
Pecan 'Pawnee'	Type I. Early maturing variety. Large nut and high kernel percentage. Scab resistant. Early pollen release

Pecan 'Sumner'	Type II. Early bearing, large, good quality. Suited for close space planting. Female flowers pollen released late.
Natives Trees, Onions, Strawberries, Bluebonnets, Herbs and Succulents	
Mayhaw - Native	Known for making the world's best jelly. Typically native to swamps but can grow in well drained soils.
Mexican Plum - Native	Beautiful, single trunked, spring flowering small tree. Grows to 25 ft tall.
Pawpaw - Native	Host to the zebra swallowtail butterfly. Small tree up tp 25 ft. Protect from direct sunlight first 2 years.
Onion set ' 1015Y	Texas famous onion. Very sweet and called 1015 in honor of the October 15 planting date for the seed. Sets are ready to plant
Onion set 'Southern Belle Red'	Red globe and sweet. Very healthy due to high concentration of quercetins (anti-oxidant compound).
Onion set 'Texas Early White'	Great flavor and easy to grow. Disease resistant. Harvast 105 days from transplants.
Strawberry 'Camarosa'	Early short day cultivar. Produces large fruit throughoutthe season. It is self pollinating and grows best in mild winter areas.
Bluebonnets	State flower of Texas. Full sun. Likes well drained soils that are alkaline.
Herbs & Greens:	
Calendula	Also called Pot Marigold. The flower is considered a flowering herb and is fairly cold hardy. It attracts beneficial pollinators to the garden.
Dill	Distinctive flavor, between fennel and celery. Great for salmon dishes. Also, host for the Black Swallowtail Butterfly
Mexican Mint Marigold	Need Tarragon for a recipe, try Mexican Mint Marigold. Easy to grow. Flowers are edible.
Microgreens	Spicy Mix. Colorful mix of greens for your salad.
Rosemary	Upright variety. Grows to 4 ft. Winter hardy to 20°F. Needs well drained soil.
